

Yin Yang Theory

Wuji - the state before Heaven and Earth, or the Dao itself. In numerology it is the number zero. Perfect circulation, without beginning or end, this is the original state of everything. This "Emptiness" and "Nothingness" symbolizes the wholeness and purity of nature as one life-without polarity.





Taiji-it represents the number one, the unity of everything following the energetic state of Wuji, the primordial cosmic qi. The inner momentum generated by Wuji creates two opposing movements, the dynamic Qi state of Taiji. It is a symbol of the univeral life force.

Yin and Yang - the one gives birth to the two. The momentum of Taiji gave birth to two types of Qi: heavy Qi and light Qi. Moving in opposite directions, the heavy Qi (Yin) descended to form the Earth while the light Qi (Yang) rose to form Heaven. Yin and Yang allows people to understand something through the expression of opposites.
